Dear Patient,

Welcome to the Family Medicine Health Center (FMHC), a nationally recognized Patient Centered Medical Home (PCMH). A Medical Home is not a building, but more of a “home base” for your health care needs. It is the **Way** we give care, the **People** who give the care and the **Place** where this happens. A Medical Home is a partnership between the doctor/provider led health care team and you, the informed patient.

An important part of the support we provide as a PCMH is respecting you as an individual, a whole person. We will not make judgments based on race, ethnicity, national origin, religion, gender, or mental or physical disabilities. Your medical information will not be shared with anyone unless you give written permission or the law requires us to do so. FMHC has chosen to participate in the Idaho Health Data Exchange (IHDE). If you do not want to participate in the IHDE and you do not want to have your health care information shared with other medical providers involved in your care, you can opt out of the participation. To opt out, you must complete and sign the IHDE “Request to Restrict Disclosure of Health Information” form and mail or fax it to IHDE. You will receive a letter of confirmation upon completion of your request. This will restrict your information from being released through the exchange only (you will need to contact directly any facility you wish to also restrict your information with).

Our mission here at FMHC is to train outstanding, broad-spectrum family medicine physicians to work in underserved and rural areas and to serve the vulnerable populations of Idaho with high quality affordable care provided in a collaborative work environment. We care about our patients and their families and strive to make all of our clinics safe and welcoming environments.
